Advanced Kevlar helmet provides total coverage of the head and face. It contains a protective chemical defense breathing apparatus. The visor has built in thermal imagers and night vision devices along with a 7GB Mp3 player and surround sound.

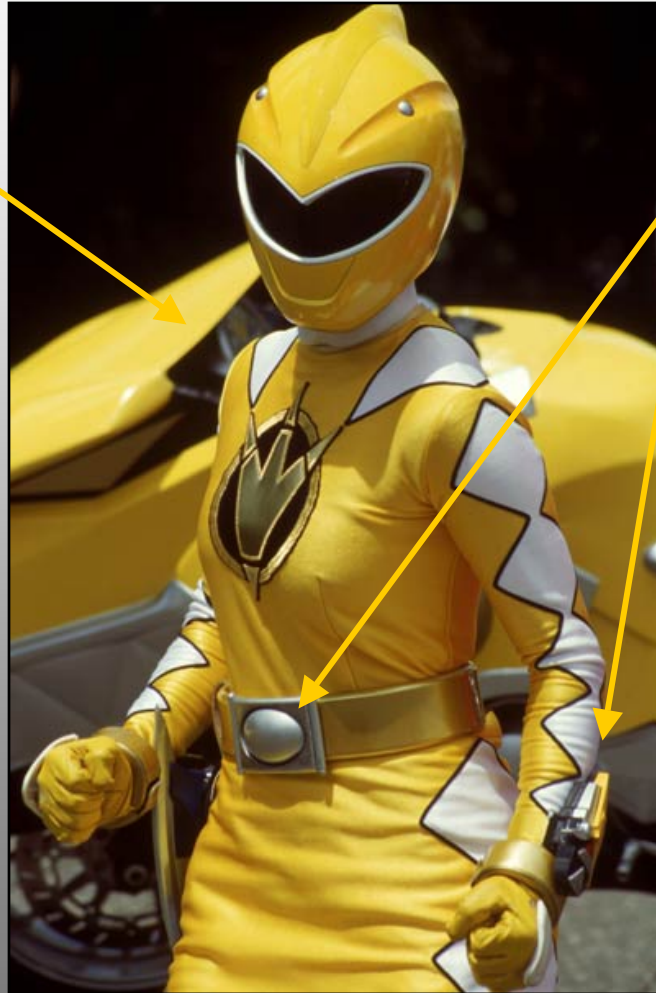

Plus it will have a built in 20,000 candle watt light bulb that will activate whenever an automobile is within 300ft. The boots will be all terrain, no-shine ultra reflective with pressure activated lights in the heel and toe.
